This is especially helpful for families who are seeking to enroll multiple children and for whom tuition is more than 10% of their net income. But you won’t know if you qualify unless you apply, and all it costs to apply is \$30 and a little bit of your time. We have contracted with a third party assessment service as a means of maintaining confidentiality and objectivity in our tuition assistance program, therefore you will submit all financial data directly to CFA, not the school.

Tuition includes all our L.A.M.M.P.S. classes (Latin, Art, Music, Mandarin, PE, and Spanish) as well as materials fees, day trips/local field trips, textbooks, and consumables (e.g. workbooks and art paper etc.) to minimize additional school fees throughout the year. Please keep in mind that our admissions process is “need-blind” (i.e. our admissions decisions are made without regard to a family’s financial need) and that we strive to make this kind of Classical and Christian education available to all who desire it and are qualified through our tuition assistance program.

If you enroll your child(ren), I have no doubt that you’ll be very impressed with what they will learn this upcoming school year. It is our prayer that you will find our vision compelling on its own merits and that you will give us the opportunity to partner with you to educate your children and bring that vision to fruition.
